Point of interest about Wray, Co. A little known historical event in this region of Eastern



Colorado. In 1868, the last Indian battle in Colorado (not in the nation) was fought at what is called Beecher Island, a mere 17 miles from Wray Colorado. Gen. Sheridan of Civil war fame, sent Maj. Forsyth & 50 scouts out from Ft. Wallace in western Kansas to subdue the Arickaree Indians. They were encamped on a small island in the Republican river when they were attacked. For 9 days the repelled multiple waves of Cheyenne, Sioux & Arapahoe Indians. Half of the men were killed or wounded. 1st Lt Frederick Beecher was among the

first to be killed and thus the island was named after him. A re-enactment occurs annually on Sept 17th.
